In the case that the desired reproduction is not offered by **b p k**, you can still order it there. The museum will supply it at no additional cost to you.

Download fees

As a registered user of high resolution with download authorisation you are entitled to directly download high resolution image files. The cost of each high resolution download is 5 € (plus value added tax). The download of layout files with watermarks is free of charge.

As a registered user without download authorisation, you can order images by citing the respective picture number or per lightbox directly with the picture agency. They will then immediately send you the desired images via download link. Please note that a service charge of 20 € is to be paid for the order of one to four motifs and 5 € for each further motifs in an order (all sums plus value added tax).

b p k Usage fees

When you use images from the b p k picture agency, you are obliged to provide us with detailed information on type of use. The usage right only becomes valid with the payment of the usage fee. The fees are calculated based on the medium of use, the distribution area as well as the form and extent of use. The fees are valid solely for one-time use for that stated purpose and scope. Please contact us in advance in order to determine the costs that will occur. We will be pleased to advise you.

Additional "Artist's Rights"

The user is responsible for observing all additional rights (for example the copyright of the illustrated artworks, personality rights, trademark marks).

Before each use of images that are still protected by copyright (copyright protection until 70 years after the artist's death), you are additionally required to obtain the right to use the artwork in question from the respective rights holder.

To the extent that the bpk knows who holds these rights, the name will be indicated in the description of the preview image under the heading "Rights".
